BURY MY HEART AT WOUNDED KNEE

Synopsis

Based on Dee Brown's bestselling novel, *Bury My Heart at Wounded Knee* powerfully explores the economic, political and social pressures that underpinned the opening of the American West and the tragic impact this expansion had on American Indian culture.

This epic and sweeping film intertwines the unique perspectives of three historic 19th century characters: Charles Eastman, né Ohiyesa, a young, college-educated, Sioux doctor held up as living proof of the alleged success of assimilation; Sitting Bull, the proud Lakota chief who refuses to submit to U.S. government policies designed to strip his people of their identity, their dignity and their sacred land – the gold-laden Black Hills of the Dakotas; and Senator Henry Dawes, who was one of the architects of the government policy on Indian affairs.

While Eastman and patrician schoolteacher Elaine Goodale work to improve life for the Indians on the reservation, Senator Dawes lobbies President Grant for more humane treatment, opposing the bellicose stance of the military. Hope rises for the Indians in the form of the Ghost Dance, a messianic movement that promises an end of their suffering under the white man. This hope is obliterated after the assassination of Sitting Bull and the massacre of hundreds of Indian men, women and children by the 7th Cavalry at Wounded Knee Creek on Dec. 29, 1890.

The FICTION Jury

Adel Al-Khadad (Russia) Director



Born in Moscow, in 1964. His father is an Iraqi scientist, his mother is a Russian doctor. Graduated from the GITIS Director's Faculty (Actors group) in 1985. Debuted (as an actor) in *The Star and Death of Joacquin Murrietta* (1982). Played in *Another Night of Shahrasada's* (1984), *The Jaguar* (1986), *The Hunt* (1987), and in movies and TV-series. *Apocrypha: Music for S.Peter and S.Paul* is his directing debut.

Jeeyeong Choi

(Korea) **Chief Producer, Drama 2 Team, Korean Broadcasting System (KBS)**

Jeeyeong Choi began his professional career as a film maker at KBS immediately after he left graduate school in 1991. Five years later he got the chance to put his name on the director credit of his own TV drama *The Police Daddy*. After his first production, he directed more than ten single plays for TV including the Korean traditional horror story *Chrysanthemum Spirit*. In 1999, Choi started work on a new serial drama *Little Prince*. Aimed at children and young adults, the education storyline dealt with stars in space and created an opportunity for young viewers to learn about astronomy over its six month run.

Choi followed this by returning to the single play format with successful productions of *Wings* and *Mannequin No.6 Younghee*. In 2002 he then restarted his career as a serial drama director with *Pit-a-pat Heart*.

This was quickly followed by weekend drama *The Bodyguard* in 2003 and the mini series *Kiss on April* in 2004, both of which consisted of 24 episodes. In 2005 he moved into the new area of High Definition drama features. He directed *The Outdoor Lamp* and *Who Murdered Kurt Cobain*, both of which were filmed

in HD with substantial financial backing from KBS and are noted critical successes. The HD Feature Drama project from 2005-2014 plans to produce 100 TV films featuring the most popular Korean contemporary works in HD.

Choi has been a member of the jury in the TV Drama Category at the 58th Prix d'Italia in Venice in 2006. He also contributed to the UNESCO-ABU Roadshow on ICT Applications (Information and Communication Technologies) in Nepal, Laos and Vietnam at the end of 2006. He visited each of the three countries as a speaker and workshop leader, instructing on mobile content production and the marketing strategy for internet based content.

Jeeyeong Choi was born in Seoul, Korea in 1967. He majored in Asian History and graduated with a bachelor's degree in Humanities and Literature from Seoul National University, Korea. At present he works as a chief producer in Drama 2 at KBS in Seoul.



John W. Hyde

(USA) Vice Chairman - Starz Media



John W. Hyde is vice chairman of Starz Media which includes Starz Animation, Film Roman and the Starz Productions live-action division. In that position Hyde has responsibility for new business, partnership development, and industry and talent relations, as well as management responsibility for Starz Home Entertainment – including the Anchor Bay and Manga brands.

Hyde was named president and COO of Starz Media in 2006, at the time when the company -then known as IDT Entertainment- was acquired by Liberty Media and made an operating unit of Starz, LLC. Prior to that he had been COO of IDT Entertainment and CEO of Film Roman since 1999. Earlier in his career, Hyde worked at or with Universal, Fox, MGM, Columbia, Warner, Disney, and Paramount.

His production credits include the feature films *Neverending Story*, *Short Circuit*, *9 1/2 Weeks*, *Lost Boys* and *Das Boot*, animated series *King of the Hill*, *The Simpsons* and *Mighty Mouse*, and live action TV series *Homicide (NBC)*, *Masters Of Horror (Showtime)*, *Masters of Science Fiction (ABC)*.

Early in his career, Hyde worked at Universal Studios, on everything from the syndicated afternoon rock 'n' roll dance program *The Lloyd Thaxton Show* to Uni Records, home of such artists as Elton John and Neil Diamond. From there he moved to the TV and film production company Filmways, and then to a number of other successful independent production companies.

Hyde is a member of both the Academy of Motion Picture Arts & Sciences and the Academy of Television Arts & Sciences where he has been nominated for 4 Emmys, winning one. He is a former officer and director of The Cousteau Society. He was also a founding member, as well as Vice Chairman and Board member, of the American Film Market. Hyde graduated from New York University with additional international economic studies at Leiden University in Holland.

Starz Media, LLC, is a programming production and distribution company operating worldwide. It includes the Film Roman, Anchor Bay Entertainment, and Manga Entertainment brands. Its units create animated and live-action programming - including theatrical films - and programming created under contract for other media companies. It distributes that programming, and programming acquired from outside producers, through home video retailers, theaters, broadcasters, ad supported and premium television channels, and Internet and wireless video distributors in the US and internationally. Starz Media is an operating unit of Starz, LLC, which is a wholly owned subsidiary of Liberty Media Corporation that is attributed to Liberty Capital Group.

The FICTION Jury

Hiroshi Kataoka

(Japan) Senior Director of Drama Product Division, NHK

Hiroshi Kataoka was born in Tokyo in 1959. He joined NHK in 1983 and has since worked on the planning, direction, and production of NHK drama programmes. Kataoka won the Hosono-Bunka Foundation Prize (Broadcast-Culture Foundation Prize) for his directorial debut project, *Network Baby* (1990). He has since worked on some of Japan's best-known television series including the weekday-morning series *Kaze No Haruka* (2006) and the year-long historical drama series *Genroku Ryoran* (1999). At the same time, he has worked on many one-off drama presentations including the Japan-UK co-production *How to Speak Japanese* (1993).

Many of his productions have won awards in Japan. Outside of television drama, Kataoka has wide-ranging experience as a director of feature films, computer games, and other entertainment software. In 2006, Kataoka also served in the Asia-Pacific Broadcasting Union as a script advisor and as a chief trainer at drama workshops. Currently, Kataoka is working on *Five*, a drama production about middle-aged basketball players trying to win a league title.

MARIANNE SÄGEBRECHT

(Austria) Actresse

Marianne Sägebrecht was born in the Bavarian town of Starnberg, close to Munich. After working as the assistant to a psychiatrist, she became a photographer before opening *Tatzelwurm*, a café which doubled up as a theatre, and forming her own theatre company. She also created the *Opera Curiosa* and set up numerous theatre festivals in Munich, Berlin and Hamburg. In 1979 Martin Sperr directed *Adele Spitzeder* at Munich's Studiotheater, a play in which Marianne featured as Bella. It was there that she was noticed by director Percy Adlon who found her acting extremely moving. A year later Adlon asked her to work with him on the TV film he was directing, *Herr Kischott*, which was to mark the beginning of their extraordinary partnership. In 1985 she starred in Adlon's film *Zuckerbaby*. Two years later Percy Adlon directed her again in *Out of Rosenheim* (Bagdad Café), a film made in the USA, in which she conducts a love affair with the character played by Jack Palance. Bagdad Café's fabulous success at the box-office contributed to Marianne's huge popularity stateside, and in 1989 she went on to star in *Rosalie Goes Shopping*, another Percy Adlon film.

Marianne Sägebrecht has featured in numerous films over the course of her career, some of the most notable ones being *Im Himmel ist die Hölle los* (1983), *Crazy Boys* (1987) by Peter Kern, *Moon over Parador* (1988) by Paul Mazursky with Richard Dreyfuss, *The War of the Roses* (1989) by Danny DeVito (with Kathleen Turner and Michael Douglas), *Martha et moi* (1990), by Jiri Weiss (with Michel Piccoli), *Dust Devil* (1991, TV) by Richard Stanley, *Mr. Bluesman* (1992) by Sönke Wortmann, *The Milky Life* (1993), *Run of Hearts, Ein fast perfektes Verhältnis* by Donald Reiker (with Uwe Ochsenknecht), *Eine Mutter kämpft um ihren Sohn, Ohne Hose, All Men Are Mortal* (1994) by Ate de Jong, *Der Unhold* (1995), by Volker Schlöndorff, *Lorenz im Land der Lügner*, by Jürgen Brauer, *Soleil*, by Roger Hanin, *Eine Frau nach Maß* (all in 1996), *Spanish Fly*, by Daphna Kastner, *Left Luggage* by Jeroen Krabbé (with Isabella Rossellini and Maximilian Schell), the European production *Asterix and Obelix vs. Caesar* (1998) by Claude Zidi (with Gérard Depardieu and Christian Clavier), *Ganz unten, ganz oben*, by Matti Geschonneck, *Die Sekretärin des Weihnachtsmanns* by Dagmar Damek, *Ich wünsch dir Liebe* (1999), *Marga Engel schlägt zurück, Der kleine Lord - Retter in der Not, Scheidung auf Amerikanisch*, by Sherry Hormann, *Das Findelkind* (2000), *Marga Engel kocht vor Wut, Großglocknerliebe - Kein Heimatfilm* (2002), *Charlotte und ihre Männer, Marga Engel gibt nicht auf* (2004), and *Bezaubernde Marie* (2007).

Morgan Wandell

**(USA) Senior Vice President, Drama Development
ABC Studios**



Morgan Wandell serves as senior vice president, drama development for ABC Studios, the television production studio of the Walt Disney Company. In his role, Mr. Wandell is responsible for the development of drama programming for the studio which created international hit franchises *Lost*, *Desperate Housewives* and *Grey's Anatomy*.

As head of the drama department, Mr. Wandell oversees a team of creative executives who identify, cultivate and develop drama programming for network broadcast and cable exhibition. His recent slate of programming includes the award-winning freshman sensation *Ugly Betty*, the compelling critically-acclaimed family saga *Brothers and Sisters*, and two successful seasons-to-date of the procedural crime drama *Criminal Minds* and Jennifer Love Hewitt's *Ghost Whisperer*.

Prior to joining ABC Studios, Mr. Wandell was president of programming for the Channel One Network, where he expanded production capabilities by creating original programming for outside networks including the highly acclaimed series *Breaking it Down with Serena* for MTV. During an earlier career with Channel One, he developed and produced news features and was the recipient of numerous film and television awards.

Mr. Wandell has also served as vice president of development for Digital Entertainment Network (DEN), the online entertainment network geared toward Generation Y. In this role, he supervised entertainment-based programming, managed production, and oversaw new content acquisitions.

Named by *The Hollywood Reporter* in 2006 as one of 35 executives in the next generation to watch, Mr. Wandell is currently working on slate of pilots for Fall 2007 that have attracted acclaimed theatrical and television actors, writers and directors.

TV SERIES Jury



Pascal Breton - President of the Jury
(France) **CEO - Marathon Group**

Pascal Breton was born in 1958. Following his studies at the Institute of Political Studies (Paris) and after obtaining a PhD in Political Studies, he started out in 1981 as producer of TF1's TV magazines *Étoiles et Toiles* (Stars and Webs) and *Megahertz*, along with Alain Sedouy. In 1983, he became a reporter for FR 3's program *Vendredi* (Friday), before going on to produce a number of movie-theme magazines for FR 3 covering the Cannes Festival (1985-1986). The following year, he produced the cultural TV show *Cherchez la France* (Looking for France) and *Souris Noire* (Black Mouse/Series), 20 thirteen-minute films co-produced by FR 3 and sold to 14 countries. In 1988, he joined Ellipse-Fiction (Canal+) as Animation Fiction Manager. Next, in 1990, he got together with Olivier Brémond to create the audiovisual production company, Marathon Productions, for which he acts as General Manager, executive producer and writer. He develops and produces Marathon's principal productions: *The Intrepids* (52 x 26'), *The Challengers* (104 x 26'), *Saint Tropez* (440 x 52'), *Dolmen* (6 x 90'). In January 2006, Marathon merged with Marathon Media, Tele Images and Adventure Line Productions to form France's second largest audiovisual group: The Marathon Group. Pascal Breton is the President of this new group.

Jules Burns
(United Kingdom)
Chief Operating Officer - All3Media

He joined Granada in 1976 where he worked until 2003. Following a range of management and business affairs roles he was appointed Joint MD, with Andrea Wonfor, of Granada Production in 1995. In this role he oversaw the bringing together of Granada, LWT, Yorkshire and Unity's production and distribution operations and the growth and acquisition of Granada's international production and education businesses. In 2000 he was appointed the MD, Operations of Granada plc.

In 2003 he set-up All3Media with two Granada colleagues, Steve Morrison and David Liddiment, with backing from Bridgepoint Capital and the company has since acquired eight independent production companies operating in the UK, the USA, Holland and New Zealand, an international distribution company now called All3Media International and a talent agency. In 2006 Bridgepoint Capital were replaced as backers for the business by Permira and in 2007 All3Media launched the process of acquiring MME, one of the largest independent production companies in Germany. Alongside his work for ALL3MEDIA he is a non-executive of Liverpool FC.



Tim Gibbons

(USA) **Producer, Director**

Tim Gibbons, an award-winning television and film Producer and Director, is currently Executive Producer of HBO's comedy Curb Your Enthusiasm. While on "Curb", he's won a Golden Globe (2003), two Producers Guild of America's Producer of the Year awards (2002 & 2004), two DGA awards (2002 & 2004), the Monte-Carlo Television Festival's Outstanding Producer of the Year, Comedy (2003), and has been nominated for three primetime Emmys, plus numerous other awards.

He recently formed Invasion TV, through which he'll create, develop and produce his own projects. Currently, he's in various stages of development on a slate of projects, including an untitled MTV scripted comedy and a reality drama that goes behind the scenes with the Los Angeles Sheriffs Department Homicide Bureau.

In 2006, he was Co-Executive Producer for HBO's single camera comedy, *The Unsuccessful Thug*, and Executive Producer and Director for A&E's hidden camera reality series, *Spying on Myself*. In 2004, Gibbons produced HBO's comedy pilot, *The Comeback*. Prior to Curb, he was Producer and Director of the hidden camera sketch comedy *The Jamie Kennedy Experiment*, and was the Supervising Producer and Director for the reality series *Ripley's Believe It or Not!*

Gibbons is on National Board of Directors for the *Producers Guild of America*, having also served as its President (with Kathleen Kennedy) in 2001-2002. He's also on the Primetime Awards and the Producers Peer Group Executive Committees for the Academy of Television Arts & Sciences.

He started his career in television with four years at Dick Clark Productions and through the years has worked on more than 125 productions, including a four-year stint as Executive in Charge of Production for First-Run Syndication for Lorimar/Telepictures.

SIGNIS 50th Anniversary of the Catholic TV in Monte-Carlo

In February 1958, the first ever International Television Meeting brought together participants from twelve different countries.

The event took place in the Principality of Monaco and was organized by the International Catholic Association for Television and Radio, UNDA, now SIGNIS, which, each year, continues to award a special prize to a programme competing in Monaco.

This experimental concept proved a resounding success, thanks notably to the wholehearted support it received from Prince Rainier III who, three years later, used it as a blueprint for creating the Monte-Carlo TV

Festival. Half a century on, we are delighted to celebrate this Christian initiative which provided a forum in which experiences and ideas could be expressed and shared, whilst providing guidance and status to religious TV programmes. This year, the Festival's special Mass will be commemorating this anniversary.

The Mass will be led, in the presence of Mgr. Jean-Michel di Falco-Leandri, Bishop of Gap, and current President of the Council of the French Episcopate for communications, by Mgr Bernard Barsi, archbishop of Monaco, in the Church of Saint-Charles, on Sunday 10 June at 6.30 pm.

SPECIAL PRIZES

> Prince Rainier III Special Prize

This prize will be awarded by H.S.H. the Prince Albert II of Monaco to the **programme in the news or fiction category** which best deals with nature conservation, the protection of the environment, the protection of threatened fauna and flora, or the fight against pollution.

> Prize of the "Monaco Red Cross"

This prize is awarded in recognition of an outstanding **news or fiction programme** that portrays at least one of the ideals of the Red Cross: humanity, impartiality, independence, neutrality, charity, unity and universality.

> Prize of the "International Committee of the Red Cross"

This prize, launched in 2003 to mark the 140th anniversary of the creation of the International Committee of the Red Cross, will be awarded to a **news programme** which promotes the principles of international humanitarian law by covering a conflict in terms of its most serious consequence: the victims.

> Amade Prize

(Association Mondiale des Amis de l'Enfance)

The aim of this prize, is to reward an outstanding **Fiction or News programme** which echoes the ideals of AMADE and which deals with an issue of human relationships, whose treatment and plot or action do not feature violence but instead encourage its rejection.

> Signis Prize

The World Catholic Association for Communication SIGNIS awards the "Silver Dove" to the **best Television Film or News programme** reflecting the goals of the association.

> International TV Audience Prize

These prizes for the largest **international TV audience** will be awarded on the basis of number of viewers, by adding together audiences on the 5 continents. The winning programmes will be those with the largest total audience in 2005 in three categories: TV Series (Drama), TV Series (Comedy) and Telenovelas / Soaps.

URTI PRIZE The International Grand Prix for Documentaries

The International Grand Prix for Documentaries is intended to recognise television productions best embodying the objectives of URTI, which deal with major social issues, and artistic and cultural subjects, and which demonstrate excellence in both choice of subject and technical approach, while making effective use of the medium of television. This Prize is one of the most distinguished awards of

the Festival. Its trophy was created by the celebrated sculptor Arman.

The Jury will also award a Silver Medal and a Bronze Medal, and may in addition decide to grant a Special Mention to one of the competing programmes. A debate with the President of the Jury will be held on Monday 11th June at 7:50 p.m., Salle Belle Epoque, Hôtel Hermitage.

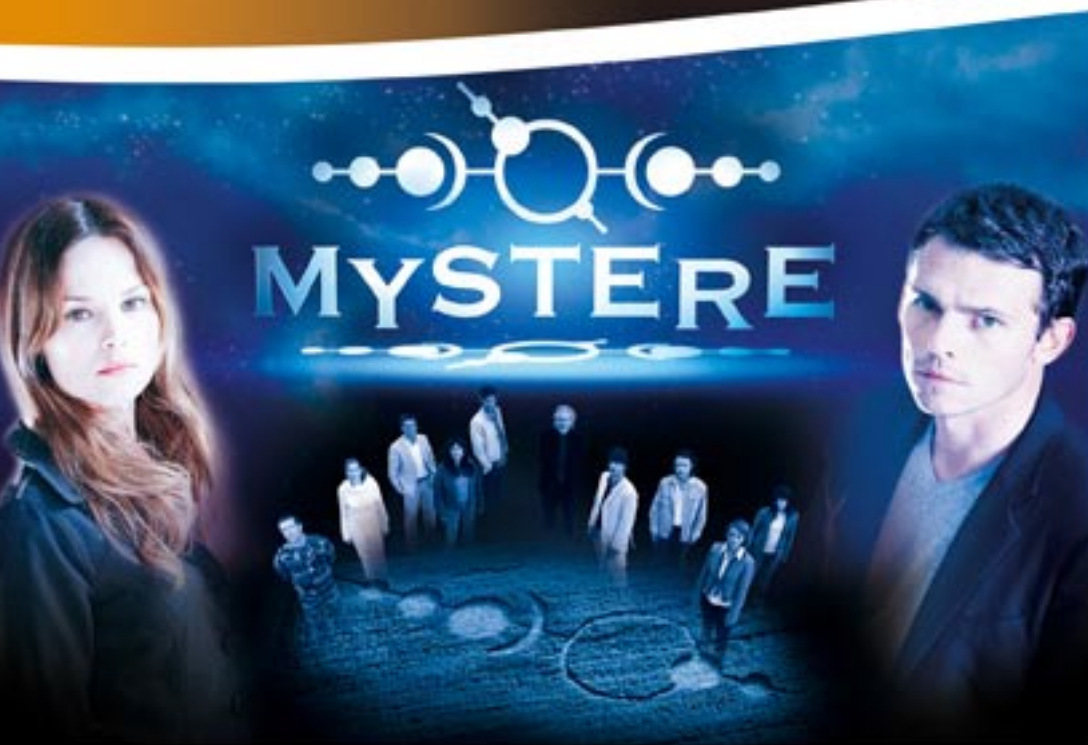

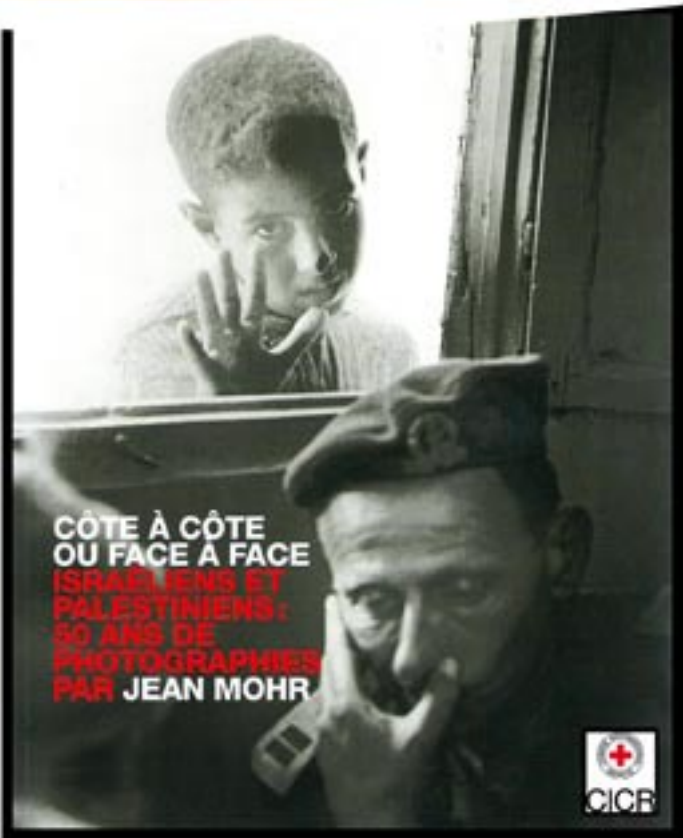
Israelis and Palestinians:

An International Committee of the Red Cross exhibition held to mark the 5th Press Award to be presented by the ICRC at the 47th Monte Carlo Television Festival. Organised in conjunction with the Monaco Red Cross, with the support of the 47th Monte Carlo Television Festival, the URTI (International Radio and Television University), France Info and the Grimaldi Forum. This exhibition of 60 photographs depicts the everyday life of people in Israel and the Palestinian territories between 1949 and 2002, and takes as its subject the faces of anxious women, concerned old people, and expectant youngsters. The exhibition also underlines the involvement of the ICRC and its local partners, the Palestinian Red Crescent and the Israeli emergency service, Magen David Adom. In casting his eye over the last 50 years, Jean Mohr subtly echoes the region's turbulent existence, one that is interspersed with occasional flickers of hope.

Jean Mohr

Jean Mohr is a photographer. For the last 50 years he has travelled the world, reporting on events in virtually every corner of the globe. Now 81, Mohr continues to pursue his career with passion. His close links with the ICRC go back to 1949-50 when he worked as a delegate in Jericho and Hebron before venturing into photography. His subsequent work represents a memoir of the conflict. He took his first photographs in the Palestinian territories in 1949 before embarking on his duties as an ICRC delegate in the refugee camps. Over the decades that followed he would return to Israel and Palestine on numerous occasions, notably during the Six-Day War in 1967. Still a frequent visitor to the region, his photographs continue to catalogue everyday life there.

The ICRC's role

The ICRC has been present in Israel, the occupied territories and the autonomous territories since the Israeli-Arab War of 1948. Its mission is to ensure the strict observation of international human rights, in particular the Fourth Geneva Convention relative to the protection of civilian persons in time of war. In the current climate of violence, the ICRC's work involves meeting

the basic humanitarian needs of the civilian population, visiting detainees, and making the necessary representations to the relevant Israeli and Palestinian authorities. The organisation comes to the direct assistance of Palestinian people who have had their houses pulled down and to those most affected by the curfews, blockades and other restrictions imposed on the towns and villages of the West Bank. In its capacity as an organisational body, the ICRC coordinates the relief activities of the international Red Cross and Red Crescent movement. In addition, it also provides support for the activities of the Palestinian Red Cross and Magen David Adom.

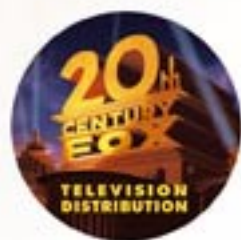
The exhibition comes to Monaco

Side by Side or Face to Face is a travelling exhibition that started out in Israel and the Palestinian territories before visiting Amman, Cairo, Beirut, Tunis and Geneva. The exhibition is being staged at Monaco's Grimaldi Forum as part of the 47th Monte Carlo Television Festival (10-14 June 2007), an event at which the ICRC has presented a special award for war reporters and documentary makers for the last five years.
